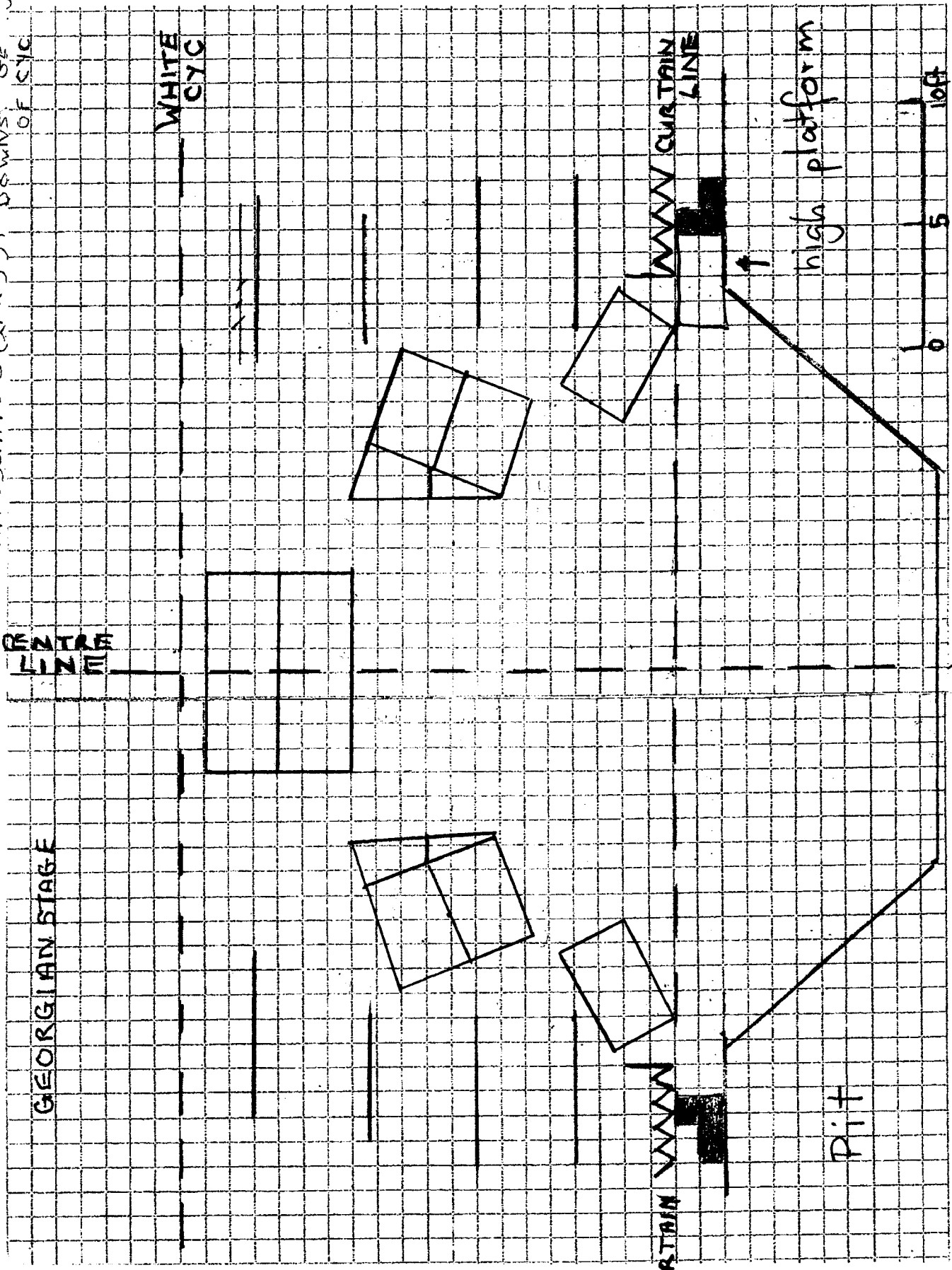

Love to sing? Love to dance? Then  is for you!



 is a newly formed show choir for children ages 8 through 14 in the Barrie area and will operate under the auspices of Bravado! Show Choir. Our mandate is to foster a love of singing, dancing and performing in a safe and fun environment. Not only will participants master control of their voices, they will have fun and make new friends.

Participation

- Participants, ages 8 through 14, will not require an audition to participate. All who wish to be a part of the organization will be given the opportunity.
- All participants will be required to sing by themselves to determine part placement.
- Participants wishing to have a solo feature will be required to audition for the solo. Notice of upcoming auditions will be given prior to the audition.
- Children under 8yrs old will be required to audition if they wish to participate in the choir.

Rehearsals

- Rehearsals will take place every Monday (including some holiday Mondays) from 4:00-6:00pm at Midhurst United Church. There will be the occasional Saturday rehearsal, mainly for setting and rehearsing choreography. There will also be a Tech Week before each major performance which will include a regular Monday rehearsal, a Wednesday Tech rehearsal in the performance space and a Thursday Dress rehearsal, also in the performance space. The Tech and Dress rehearsals may run late.
- A rehearsal schedule will be posted at the beginning of each session.
- Attendance will be taken at each rehearsal. Any participant who is absent for more than 3 rehearsals, may be in jeopardy of performing in the upcoming concert or gig.

Performances

- Each year, participants will perform in the two major performances hosted by Bravado! Show Choir. The dates for 2018-19 performances are:
 - Christmas Season Concert at Collier Street United Church
 - November 30 at 7:30pm
 - December 1 at 2:00pm (shorter matinee)
 - December 1 at 7:30pm

- Spring Season Concert at Georgian Theatre
 - May 3 at 7:30pm
 - May 4 at 7:30pm
- In addition, the choir will have the opportunity to perform at festivals and private functions around town. These will be arranged on an ad hoc basis. Examples of some of these opportunities would be the Barrie Music Festival and Celebrate Barrie.

Membership Dues

- Each participant will pay membership dues at the following rates:
 - Fall Session Only (September through December) \$125
 - Spring Session Only (January through May) \$125
 - Full Year (September through May) \$225
- A Music Fee of \$20 is required from all participants. Music and folders will be distributed at the first rehearsal of each session and then returned at the end of the performance period.

Volunteering

- For an organization to succeed, we need people to be involved with the organization. We ask the family of the each participant to help in one or more of the following categories:
 - **Fundraising**
No show can be staged without money, and members (and parents) are expected to assist with fundraising throughout the year. This may include additional performances, assisting at fundraising events, and other duties as they arise. Sponsorship opportunities are always welcome, so any ideas for future sponsorship are appreciated.
 - **Marketing/Ticket Sales**
Each member will be given an allotment of tickets for each show. Members should use every opportunity to sell tickets to family and friends. Additional tickets are available, if required. Any ideas regarding the sale of tickets in bulk to outside associations etc. are very welcome!
 - **Chaperoning**
All parents are required to volunteer their chaperoning services during full day rehearsals (usually Saturdays), and during the week of the show. A schedule will be arranged in order that each parent will also have the opportunity to watch the show on one of the two performances.
 - **Costumes/Props**
Costumes will be designed and provided by Bravado! Kids. There will be a fee for performance costumes. Props will be provided, when required, at no cost.
